## Reading Disability & Genetics Study

<b>What are we studying?</b>	We are studying the genetic risk factors for developing reading difficulties in children.
<b>Who can participate?</b>	We are seeking native English-speaking 2 <sup>nd</sup> to 10 <sup>th</sup> graders with a significant reading difficulty. We are also recruiting additional siblings and family members.
<b>What is the testing procedure?</b>	Each child will be mailed a phone-based testing packet. Testing will take about an hour. Each participant will also be asked to provide a saliva sample. All personal data will be de-identified so as to remain confidential.
<b>Are there any benefits for the participants?</b>	Yes. Each child participant will receive a \$25 gift certificate. Parents may request the test scores from the assessment, though these are strictly research-based and do not reflect clinical diagnosis.
